Adoration

1 Chronicles 16:23-25,27 Sing to the LORD, all the earth; proclaim his salvation day after day. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all the people. For great is the LORD and most worthy of praise. Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy in his dwelling place.

Philippians 2:10-11 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is LORD, to the glory of God the father.

Take some time to praise and adore the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Confession

2 Chronicles 7:14 if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and forgive their sin and heal their land.

Philippians 1:6 being confident in this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Take some time to silently confess your sins to God knowing that he hears and forgives you.

Thanksgiving

1 Chronicles 29:10-13 Praise be to you, O LORD, God of our father Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, O LORD, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all. Now, our God, we give you our thanks, and praise your glorious name.

Philippians 4:8 Finally brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things.

Take some time to thank God for what he has done, what he is doing and what he will do.

Supplication

2 Chronicles 6: 19, 35 Yet give attention to your servant's prayer and his plea for mercy, O LORD my God. Hear the cry and prayer that your servant is praying in your presence. Then hear from heaven their prayer and plea, and uphold their cause.

Philippians 4:6-7 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
