***Call to Worship**

Psalm 19

Leader: The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the works of his hands.

People: Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. Yet their voice goes out to the ends of the earth, their words to the ends of the world.
